# LKS2 Curriculum Newsletter Spring 2 2024

During Spring 2 we have started our new topic 'Out and About'. This will last 4 weeks and then we will be starting to audition, rehearse and practise a play called 'Time Lord'. We hope to then perform this to parents and the school in Summer 1. The topic web below outlines how the different subject areas will be covered. Please note: Some activities may change or different activities may be added depending upon which areas the class choose to investigate further.

## **English** The Write Stuff:

This term we will be exploring exciting vocabulary, learning about different sentence structures and grammatical features and also taking part in experience lessons to ignite the children's imaginations! The children will be looking at 'The Wizards of Once' by Cressida Cowell and will be creating a newspaper report.



### P.E

The children will be practising different ball skills and playing different team games.





#### **Maths** – Maths Mastery (White Rose Maths)

**Year 3** – We are learning about Measuring (comparing and converting), Perimeter and Adding and Subtracting lengths.

We will be learning Fractions, denominators and numerators, comparing and ordering fractions and knowing what a whole is.

Year 4 – We are learning about Measuring (comparing and converting), Perimeter and Adding and Subtracting lengths.

We will be learning Fractions, understanding a whole, partitioning mixed numbers and looking at proper and improper fractions.

# R.E

The children will be learning about Christianity, looking at the Story of Easter and understanding the impact of Jesus' death. We will be recounting the events of the Last supper and looking into the possible reasons for Jesus' death.



#### Learning Means the World – Dimensions Curriculum

Our "Out and About" topic has a Geography focus all about the UK and the area we live in.



Geography - The children will learn about the UK and its regions, countries, mountains and rivers. We will learn about the eight compass points and look at Ordinance Survey maps. We will look at physical and human features and hope to do some fieldwork in the local area.



 History - The children will learn about the local area, comparing Henley now to Henley in the past.



**PSHE** - We will be talking about collaboration, resilience, listening skills and bullying.



• **Science** – The children will learn about the geology of the local area.



**ART** – The children will be observing and sketching prominent buildings and using a variety of different media.
