Who is my neighbour?

The topic web below outlines how the different subject areas will be covered. Please note: Some activities may change or different activities may be added depending upon which areas the class choose to investigate further.

History

Our topic this term is 'The Vikings'. We will be looking at who they were, where they came from and why they invaded and settled in Britain. We will find out why they were so successful, especially in warfare. Using historical sources, we will discover what they ate, wore and how and where they lived. We will also be looking at their beliefs, art and culture as well as trying to gauge their impact on Britain and their enduring legacy. Finally, we will examine the impact the Vikings had through their voyages of discovery and their extensive trade links.

Art & DT

Both Art and DT will be closely linked to Viking culture.

In Art, the children will look at - amongst other things - runes, Viking knot designs, shield and sail decorations. In DT, they will study Viking longhouses, longships, helmets and the materials and technologies required to make them

RE

What is meant by a good life? We are exploring this through studying Islam, Muhammad, the Qu'ran and the muslim belief in heaven.

English

This half term in English we are writing postcards in character - villains in prison! We have also been looking at balanced report writing, examining the features of a balanced report and how to construct introductions and conclusions. Of course, we have been working hard on our spelling, punctuation and grammar revision in readiness for next week - the children have made so much progress.

Maths

Year 6 have been preparing for the SATs through a combination of curriculum completion and revision, in normal lesson times, supplemented by extra Arithmetic sessions, weekly Pixl tests, Maths 'boosters' and some targeted smaller interventions on Wednesday and Friday afternoons. Holiday homework and weekly homework has been set. After SATs, any areas of the curriculum that need more work will be covered and there should be some time for some 'Investigations' Year 5 have been continuing with the White Rose Maths and our currently nearing the end of their work on Fraction...Decimals and Percentages will ensue.

Science

We have started this term finishing off our work on Life Cycles. This will conclude with a study of the human lifecycle which will tie in nicely with the teaching of SRE in PSHE. We will then be studying 'Light' for the rest of the term.

PSHE

This term in PSHE, we will be studying 'Relationships and Sex Education'. Through discussions, the children will learn about self-image, body image, puberty and feelings.
