## English -

## Learning Means The World – Out and About in the UK

This term, our topic **Out and About in the UK** will focus on geography. Children will be exploring counties, cities, and regions of the United Kingdom, learning to identify human and physical features, and using maps, compasses, and grid references. They will also carry out local fieldwork to observe and record features of our area, helping them understand why it is the way it is. In addition, children will take part in a weekly PSHE lesson to support their personal and social development.

## Maths

In Maths, **Cowell Class** will continue practicing the four rules of number using informal and formal methods, with a focus on multiplication, division, and fractions, including adding, subtracting, and finding fractions of a number. They will also study length and perimeter.

**Coelho Class** will further develop multiplication and division skills, explore length and perimeter, and study fractions, including equivalent, mixed, and improper fractions. **Pilkey Class** will focus on fractions with Mr Clarke, continue exploring length and perimeter with Miss Newman, and then move on to money.

## RE - Who do Christians believe Jesus is?

This term in RE, children will learn about the Holy Trinity and how Christians believe God sent His Son, Jesus, to guide and save humanity. They will explore Jesus' names, link them to Bible stories including Easter, and consider why Christians believe He came to earth
