Learning Means The World - British Bulldog and Fighting Footballer

This term, we have started our 'A world of bright ideas' unit in Learning Means the World, which focuses on the creative process of invention and design. We will look at important inventions over time, before moving on to learning about more current issues such as patenting and copyright. We will actively engage in the design and make process, looking at the steps involved from generating a concept to producing a commercially viable product.

English - The Write Stuff: This term's writing unit will be based on the short animation 'One Small Step' by Taiko Studios, in their writing lesson the children will be working through the Writing Rainbow, looking at complex sentences, sentence structure and variety of punctuation to improve our writing. At the end of the unit, the children will complete an independent piece of writing, using the features they have learnt in their writing lessons.

PE -

The children will be having PE lessons taught by MNR coaches as well as teacher led sessions.

Forest School -

The children have begun their much loved Forest School sessions, on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday afternoons.



RE - ODBE Schools

This term, our big question is: What does it mean to live a good life?

The children will explore their knowledge of the world explained by both faith and science, while continuing to link back to the big question.

Maths - Maths Mastery (White Rose Maths)

UKS2 have been developing their understanding of **place value**, working with increasingly larger numbers and exploring the value of each digit. We have also been strengthening our skills in the **four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division**, practising efficient written methods, solving problems and explaining their mathematical thinking.

The children will also be completing weekly short arithmetic tests.
