Writing

This term's writing unit will be about the story: Ruby's Worry. We will be focusing on words that describe emotions and look at different describing words to identify how they feel.

Maths

In maths, our initial focus will be to complete the Baseline assessment. Once completed we will be looking at numbers to 5, how to subitise and order numbers, knowing which number is one more or one less. We will also be looking at repeating patterns using 2, 3, and 4 different types of colours and shapes.
