English - This term's writing unit will be based on 'The Bear and the Piano' by David Litchfield. The children will be developing their creativity and writing skills by planning and writing their own adventure story. Each lesson will focus on a key part of the story's structure, helping the children to build their ideas step by step. As they write, the children will be encouraged to include a variety of writing techniques from the Writing Rainbow, such as adjectives, repetition for effect, comparatives, dialogue, questions, time adverbials and verbs.

Maths - Maths Mastery (White Rose Maths)
Year 1 - Place Value (within 10) Children will sort & count objects, including from larger groups. They will represent objects, recognise numbers as words, count on to 10, find one more or less, & compare amounts using fewer than, greater than, or equal to.
Year 2 - Place Value Children will deepen their understanding of numbers to 100. They'll learn to count in steps of 2, 3, 5, & 10, recognise tens and ones, & use number lines & place value charts.
Shape - Children will learn about 2D and 3D shapes, including how many sides, vertices, edges and faces.

Learning Means The World (Inter-Nation Media Station)

During this unit, the children will learn about media and broadcasting. There is a key subject focus on history and the children will learn about early methods of communication, leading to the invention of both the television and radio. They will look at the advantages and disadvantages of various media and discuss what we have learnt from the past.

PE -

The children's PE sessions will be led by sports coaches from Performance Sports (tag rugby) and MNR (Manipulation & Coordination). Children will be taught skills in basic tag rugby, learning the rules and developing tactics and will be invited to a tag rugby festival in November (further details to follow shortly). Children will also work with others while controlling an object within a space and will learn to coordinate body parts in a variety of activities and in different ways.

RE - ODBE Schools

This term, our big question is: What does Torah mean for Jewish people?

The children will find out what is in the Torah and how Jewish people use it. They will discover that it contains history and rules. We will read a range of stories from the Torah, especially those that link to Jewish festivals including the story of Creation and the stories about Abraham. They will learn that the Jewish day begins in the evening, at sundown. We will explore the 10 Commandments and learn about the synagogue.
