



This half term, the children in UKS2 will be learning about all things America!

Our topic '*Come Fly With Me!*' will explore a broad range of historical, geographical and cultural aspects related to North America.

Towards the end of term we will be inviting parents and carers into school to visit our America exhibition.

In preparation for this, for our LMTW homework this term, we are asking the children to design and develop their own exhibition 'stand' on one of the following topics:

- The discovery of America and the indigenous populations;
- A famous landmark - either natural or manmade;
- One of the 50 states of America;
- Nature - plants, animals or climates;
- The American Dream;
- American food;
- Artists;
- Dance and music;
- The star spangled banner anthem and flag.

The exhibition 'stand' can be designed and presented in any appropriate way - it should be large enough for other people to be able to read clearly and be attractive and interesting. The children may already know a lot about their chosen topic and even have things they can bring in or add onto their stand, or they may wish to undertake more in-depth research to produce their finished piece.

Whilst we will be studying the above aspects in school, we will not be creating our exhibition pieces in lessons - this should be done at home by the children. They can, if they wish, work with a friend to do this.

We will let you know when the exhibition is and when the (nearly!) finished stands should be brought into school for final tweaking and presentation.
