Learning Means The World - Come Fly With Me, America!

This is a wide-ranging and engaging thematic unit based on North and Central America with a key focus on geography and history. It begins with the location of countries and states before learning about the discovery of America and the Native American people. We will also study weather and climate, as well as human and physical features/landmarks. After some Jackson Pollock inspired art and line dancing, the unit ends with an explanation of 'The American Dream' whilst examining the values of freedom and tolerance.

English

This term, our narrative writing unit is based on the short, silent film 'The Fantastic Flying Books of Mr Morris Lessmore'.

Using literary devices including: inner thoughts, short sentences for impact, similes and personification, the children will write their own fantasy narratives by taking the film's central idea and applying it to their own plot.



Maths

This term, Year 6 will be finishing some short topics on algebra and ratio prior to entering into some revision lessons in preparation for the upcoming SATs in May.

Year 5 are working on calculating and problem solving with decimal numbers and percentages.

The children will also continue to with the weekly short arithmetic tests to allow us to check for understanding and refine our lessons accordingly. .

RE

This term, UKS2 is learning about how a world view helps people to decide what is important.

The children will be considering their experience of RE so far to explore what influences beliefs have on the choices people make about what is important to them.

PE Year 6 will be honing their cricket skills this term and with the MNR coaches, year 5 and 6 will be practising their athletics events.

Year 5 will be swimming and learning self-rescue and water safety.
