

Curriculum Newsletter - Autumn 2 2025



Our current module is 'Rocky the Findosaur.' It covers a lot of Science looking at the 3 main rock types and different types of soils. Mid November, we move onto our next module which is 'Lindow Man' the story of prehistoric man. We will learn how the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age took place. We will study who the Celts were, in particular, Boudicca and learn how the Iron Age people showed a sense of community by providing shelter in their hill forts for local populations during war. We study the evidence that exists for these different historical periods (Stonehenge, Scara Brae etc.) and learn how the people living during these three periods of time influenced the locality.
