EYFS Curriculum Newsletter Summer 1 2024

Core Value: Forgiveness



During Summer 1 we will be working on Come Fly with Me. The topic web below outlines how the different subject areas will be covered. Please note: Some activities may change or different activities may be added depending upon which areas the class choose to investigate further.

English The Write Stuff: This term we will be exploring exciting vocabulary, learning about different sentence structures and grammatical features. We will be working on the story "We are going on a Bear Hunt! We will be looking at describing words for our 5 senses. We will also be retelling the sort using our own work and creating a different ending to the story.



The children will be learning all about different ball and bat skills on a Monday with the PE coach. He will be teaching the children how to hold a bat, stand to receive the ball and develop hand eye coordination between the ball and bat. On a Friday we will be in the hall working on dance.





Maths - Maths Mastery (White Rose Maths)

In Maths in EYFS this term, we will be focusing on combing counting confidently to 20, identifying one more and one less from any given number from 1 to 20. We will be learning how to add and subtract any number from between 1-20. We will be then looking at shapes, in relation to Tangrams, how do we made a large shape, using small shapes. We will learn how we rotate shapes in Tangrams that will enable the child to make another shape.

R.E – In RE we will begin by looking at the story The Boy Who Cried Wolf, we will discuss the story, asking questions such as: How did the villagers feel at the beginning? Why did the boy tell lies? How did the boy/villagers feel at the end of the story? We will discuss honesty and why we need to be honest.

We will then continue with the story the Crocodile and the Priest, were we will look at how other people's words make us feel.







